Notice is hereby given to taxpayers of **ADAMS TOWNSHIP, Hamilton County**, Indiana, reorganized under the provisions of the Government Modernization Act (IC 36-1.5 et. seq.), that the proper officers of **ADAMS TOWNSHIP** will conduct a public hearing on the year **2025** budget for the reorganized township. Following this meeting, any ten or more taxpayers may object to a budget, tax rate, or tax levy by filing an objection petition with the proper officers of **ADAMS TOWNSHIP** not more than seven days after the hearing. The objection petition must identify the provisions of the budget, tax rate, or tax levy to which taxpayers object. If a petition is filed, **ADAMS TOWNSHIP** shall adopt with the budget a finding concerning the objections in the petition and testimony presented. Following the aforementioned hearing, the proper officers of **ADAMS TOWNSHIP** will meet to adopt the following budget:
